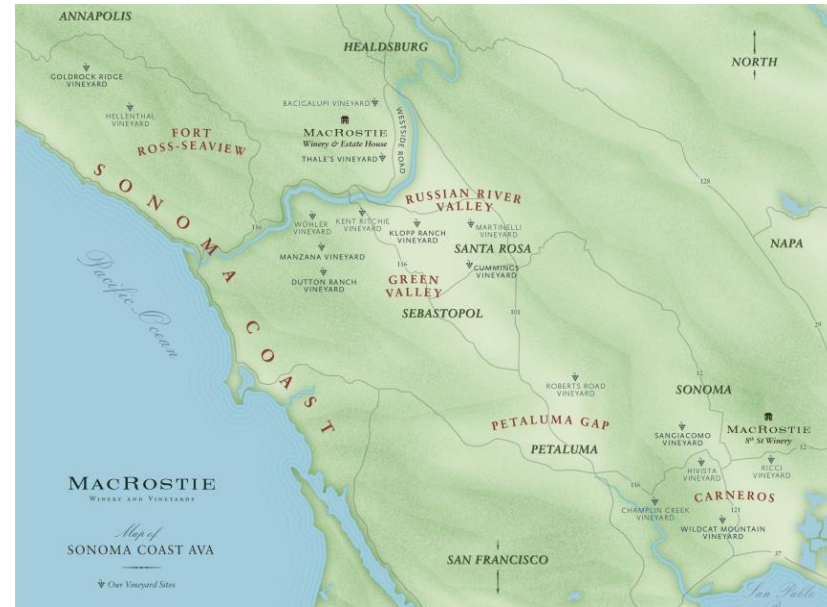


HISTORY

- In 1997 Steve MacRostie planted his Wildcat Mountain Vineyard, a fog-shrouded site with ideal mountain terroir and volcanic soils, located in Petaluma Gap. Its the backbone of our brand and is still the largest source for MacRostie wines.
- Today, our stunning new Estate House & Winery is located in Healdsburg in the heart of the Russian River Valley, surrounded by our estate Thale's Vineyard.
